Fiberweb Geosynthetics Ltd recognise its duty and have a strong commitment to all stakeholders (employees, customers, shareholders, suppliers and the community) while undertaking all activities related to the design, manufacture, sale of its products. Fiberweb Geosynthetics Ltd also recognises the need to continually improve their performance in meeting or surpassing the Occupational Health, Safety, Welfare and Environmental interests of all their stakeholders.

The Leadership team will ensure that this policy is communicated to all employees or individuals who conduct work for the business and other interested parties, and will promote understanding of the policy and the responsibility of individual employees for its effective implementation.

The business will set and manage progress towards the achievement of detailed objectives that support the top-level objectives stated below:

- To comply with all relevant Safety and Environmental legislation and regulations. It also aims to establish higher standards of performance where practical and appropriate.
- To use planned and systematic processes to understand Occupational Health, Safety and Environmental risks within the business and to take appropriate action to eliminate or reduce those risks so far as is reasonably practicable.
- To train employees to the appropriate standards required to undertake their role safely and without endangering the environment.
- To establish key Occupational Health, Safety and Environmental measures within the business and to proactively manage improvement in those measures.
- To establish and regularly review the aspects of the business that impact on the environment and to continually improve those impacts to eliminate pollution.
- To run Occupational Health, Safety, Welfare and Environmental management programmes committed to the prevention of injury, ill health and pollution supported by improvements specific to the need of the objectives.
- To use planned and effective audit processes to provide data on how well the management system is operating and to identify where corrective actions are needed.
- To use proactive processes to identify potential Occupational Health, Safety or Environmental failures and implement actions to prevent such failures occurring.

This policy will be maintained as part of the documented Management System and will be regularly reviewed for continuing suitability and will be formally reviewed at least annually.
